1.Age Limit: Players should be born on or after **01-01-2004**

Championship will be played under Swiss System and the number of rounds and schedule will depend on number of participants. The schedule and time can be changed accordingly.

Age Proof: Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age

Certificates from School are not valid. Certificates shall be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.

- **The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the child alone will be recognized and allowed to participate.
- 2. Eligibility: Only Pondicherry state players can participate in the event.
- 3. Entry fee: Rs. 300/-

Players should bring your own chess boards & clock

- **4. Tie Break**: Following is the order of tie-break:
 - 1. Buchholz Cut 1
 - 2. Buchholz
 - 3. Sonneborn-Berger
 - 4. Direct encounter
 - 5. The greater number of wins including forfeits
 - 6. Number of wins with Black pieces
- **5. Protest:** Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- within 15 Minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- **6. Appeals Committee**: Before the commencement of the tournament, a three-member appeals committee shall be formed by the PSCA
- 7. Withdrawal: If any player is absent for any round without intimation to Chief Arbiter will be removed for all the remaining rounds without further notice
- **8. 50 move rule and 3-fold repetition:** 50 move rule and 3-fold repetition rule will be automatically enforced
- **9.** Top 4 boys and Top 4 girls and consolation prizes will be awarded with cups
- **10.** Top 4 boys and Top 4 girls from this age group will be selected to represent the Pondicherry State in forth coming National U19 chess championship held at Gujarat from 20-28 September 2023
